Offset Home and Car

- Choose your state.
- Identify how many people live in your household.
- Confirm how many vehicles you have.
- Use Qantas Points to offset, or choose to pay with cash and earn 10 Qantas Points per \$1 spent on the offset.

The average annual cost to offset home energy doesn't cost a lot, but can make a big impact

# of people in household	# of Cars	Annual cost (\$)	Annual cost (Points)
1	0	\$50	6,300 Pts
1	1	\$100	12,000 Pts
2	1	\$120	15,500 Pts
2	2	\$170	21,200 Pts
4	2	\$200	26,000 Pts



If just 100,000 frequent flyers offset their home and car emissions for a year, more than 1 million tonnes of carbon could be removed – the same amount that would be saved from installing 170,000 rooftop solar panels.



Fly Carbon Neutral

11% of customers on qantas.com offset their carbon emissions from flying.



Qantas matches customer contributions dollar for dollar.

Offsetting a domestic flight can be as little as one dollar

Route	Cost (one way)
Sydney – Melbourne	\$1.00
Sydney – Perth	\$4.50
Sydney – Singapore	\$6.50
Melbourne – Los Angeles	\$17.00
Sydney – London	\$23.00



In the last two years, together with our customers, the Fly Carbon Neutral program has offset in excess of half a million tonnes of CO₂ – the equivalent of taking over 200,000 cars off the road.

We have been operating one of the largest carbon offsetting programs in the global aviation industry for more than a decade now.



\$50 million to be invested to help with the development of a local sustainable aviation fuel.



In 2019, we announced a commitment to reducing 75% of Qantas Group onshore waste to landfill by the end of 2021, as well as the removal of 100 million single use plastic items. We were on track but COVID-19 health and safety requirements meant we had to pause some initiatives temporarily.
